

ROCK SPRINGS — Thirty percent of Rock Springs businesses sold alcohol to minors during a recent police compliance check.

Rock Springs Police Cmdr. Matt Keslar said the police department sent minors into businesses 123 times. Out of those visits, businesses sold alcohol to minors 37 times.

Eleven of those 37 that sold to minors also failed a second check.

Keslar says businesses failed despite being given notice about the compliance checks. He said the compliance rate was about the same as in a check last year.
